However, the size of the group is limited to assure that there is time at each meeting for members to read their work and for discussion. The group is usually at capacity; but, we maintain a pool of potential members so that new members can be elected when there is an opening.

Writers interested in joining the group are welcome to attend as a visitor. Visitors normally attend two sessions. The first session is to observe our group and listen to members' readings. We will ask the visitor to describe their interests and what they hope to achieve by joining the Rough Writers. At the second session, the visitor may read if there is time.
